#### Model Answers

- (1) As shown in Figure 1, fathers in Japan have more than 30 weeks of paid parental leave available to them. This is more than any other country in the world. It is almost double the leave available in South Korea, which is the second highest country. It is much higher than other developed countries like Finland and Germany. However, as clearly shown in Figure 2, very few men take paid parental leave. Although the percentage is increasing, in 2015 only about 2% of Japanese working men took paid parental leave, compared to about 80% of Japanese working women. (98 words)
- (2) The information shows that it is mostly women who take paid parental leave in Japan, even though it is available to men, and I think there should be more gender balance. The first reason is that these days, often both parents work, and this will allow women to continue working without taking a long break. In this way, they can continue to contribute to society and build a satisfying career, just like their partners. The second reason is because spending time with children is important for both mothers and fathers. Fathers should also benefit from time dedicated to building strong relationships with their children. For these reasons, gender balance in childcare benefits children and parents. (115 words)
